

Resuming Archery Barnstaple Archery Club

We have been given the go ahead to resume archery at Petroc, at the normal shooting times only – Tuesday and Thursday 5.30pm-Dusk and Saturday 12.30-4.30pm

Please adhere to the following guidance:

- You must read and understand <https://www.archerygb.org/wp-content/uploads/2020/05/Guidance-Notes-for-Clubs-Update-4-July.pdf> before returning to the club. Please contact a member of the committee if you have any problems accessing this.
- At start of shooting 1 key holder only should open container, key safe, target store, move bucket of ground pins and cleaning wipes outside container, distribute target face and pins to archers arriving for first time (to keep - see note above). Same key holder lay out tape measure and shooting line. Ideally the same key holder should pack all this away at the end of the session. This key holder MUST sanitise hands immediately before and immediately after both set-up and pack away.
- Normal Archery rules apply regarding moving targets and setting up the range, so 2 people per boss. However whilst moving bosses with another person, **masks** must be worn. Hands must be sanitised with hand sanitiser (provided) immediately before and immediately after handling the bosses/ground pins/hammer/trolley handle. You may also choose to wear disposable gloves. Ground pins to be stored on top of wheeled targets.
- Shooting will be limited to 6 bosses at any one time.
- Bosses must be spaced 4m apart.
- Each boss may have up to 2 archers shooting from a different household – they must shoot in 2 details keeping social distancing at all times. Any number of archers may share a boss if they are from the same household. If archers prefer to shoot alone on a boss that is absolutely fine.
- Name and keep your own target face (from Club supplies) and pins – retain them in your own kit and do not return to Club storage
- Lost Arrows: Usual BAC procedure apply – in addition: One archer (at discretion of arrow owner) uses metal detector. Hands to be sanitised immediately before and after use and metal detector to be wiped down afterwards. All other archers helping to look must wear masks. Only the arrow owner touches the arrow.
- If using arrow jack please sanitise hands before use. After use wipe down with wipes and sanitise hands again.
- You must not return/swap club kit. If you have club kit please keep it with you/at home for the duration. If you need to borrow club kit please ask a committee member.
- After shooting all shared surfaces must be must be wiped down with provided wipes, which should be placed in a bin bag. Shared surfaces include: Container handle, container bar, padlock, key safe, target store key, target store padlock, target store gate, pins used for holding doors open. One attending archer should take the bag home for safe and hygienic disposal after each session. Please let a committee member know when these start to get low.

Shooting will have to be pre-booked via BACBACS WhatsApp group – if you do not have access to this please contact Luke on 07780915598

Please also note the following:

- There are **no toilet or handwashing facilities** available on site. Please bring hand sanitiser with you when you are shooting.
- You will have to go off site should you need toilet facilities.

We have had to take the decision to cancel the August tournament. Indoor facilities will not be available until college resumes in September (we hope), and neither will safe social distancing be possible.
